IMPORTANT SHAKEN BABY SIMULATOR NOTES

Shaken Baby Simulator requires four "C" batteries. A red light flashing on the back of the baby indicates that batteries need to be replaced before the simulator will operate. (See *Instructor Quick Reference* for battery replacement instructions.)

- * If baby is stored in a very cold or very hot environment, allow 24 hours for baby to adjust to a moderate temperature before use.
- * Dramatic changes in temperature can cause water condensation inside baby. Allow time for the condensation to evaporate before use.
- * Use only the items provided to you when caring for the baby (clothing, blanket, diaper, bottle, etc.).
- * Keep baby away from any newly purchased and unwashed fabrics (e.g., clothing, blankets, linens, table clothes) as certain color dyes will stain and discolor the baby's vinyl skin, resulting in permanent damage. If such damage occurs, the school district will be held financially responsible.
